

How to Make Your Book

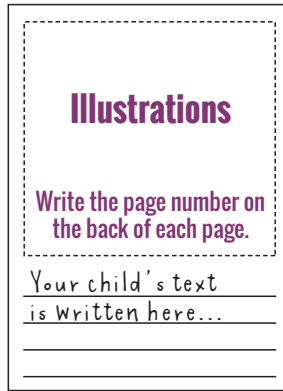
You may create one book per kit. Use the Book Cover and Story Pages included in your kit to write and illustrate your book. We have included a few extra pages in your kit for practice or corrections. For Best Results: Use dark pencil or ink for story text. For illustrations, use the markers included in your kit. Do not use colored pencils, crayons, stickers, glue or tape.

Spelling: We do not correct spelling or provide editing services. Please make sure writing is legible.

Page Numbers: Your book may include up to 16 Story Pages. Write the page number in pencil on the back of each Story Page. If you do not include page numbers, your book will be printed in the order in which the pages are received.

Printing: Books are printed in the USA usually within two weeks of the date your materials are received.

Shipping: Following printing, books are usually delivered to you in 3-5 business days. Printed books can be shipped only to addresses within the USA.

Ordering: Complete the enclosed order form and return it with your completed cover and story pages using the postage-paid envelope included in your kit.

How to Make Your Book (cont.)

About the Author Photo: Each book includes an About the Author section on the back cover. You may include a photo to accompany the About the Author text. Write your last name, as it appears on your order form, on the back of a 2" x 3" photo and include it with your book pages when you mail in your materials. Please do not paperclip or tape the photo to the page. Your photo will not be returned with your finished book.

Additional Copies: Your book is a wonderful keepsake and makes an ideal personalized gift, especially for family members, schoolmates and friends. To order additional copies go to <http://www.lulujr.com/order> and enter the Book ID code provided on the back cover of the finished book. You can share the code with friends and family, and they can order additional copies as well.
